1. Curricular Aspects

Regular Conduct of Academic Audit

- There is a long term plan to initiate the construction of new buildings for appropriate offices of for N.S.S., N.C.C., and upgrade computer laboratories, medical unit, IQAC office, etc.
- Parking facility to be augmented.


Qualitative Strengthening of Existing Programmes

- Enhanced use of ICT in Teaching Learning System: The college shall increase the use

 presentations, models, internet connections, smart classrooms, Interactive Language
 Laboratory, Computing Laboratory, Commerce and Management Resource Centre,
 etc.
- The college shall integrate online teaching and learning resources into the curriculum and teaching strategies.

- Promote humanized learning and teaching with a focus on students social and emotional developments.
- Development of Linkages with regional academic institutions such as USTM, Tezpur University and industries such as ABITA, BCPL, NEC, NEDFI, OIL.ONGC etc.

Curriculum Design and Development

- Further Active Participation & representation of College in Curriculum Design and Development
- The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) shall be adopted and implemented in all semesters. We shall have additional range of programme options, course options, course combinations, number of applied component groups, certificate and diploma programmes, bridge and remedial programmes.
- Utilizing option of new platforms such as SWAYAM/MOOC/NPTEL etc.

Teaching-Learning Process

- Admission process to be done online gradually in all semesters
- Ensuring healthy student attendance
- Promoting student friendly Environment further
- Continuing the efforts in organizing seminars / workshops / faculty development programmes collaborating with UGC, DST, DBT, NGOs, GOs etc. for improvement of quality of faculty.
- The College shall continue the policy to depute faculty for seminars / workshops / faculty development programmes organized by other institutions at different levels including attending seminars abroad.
- The college shall strengthen the system of Teachers' evaluation by students by making it more systematic and transparent. It shall bring more accountability, readiness to receive criticism and developing a sense of introspection.
- The College shall also strengthen the self-appraisal system of teachers to excel in their academic performance.
- Meetings of faculty shall be conducted periodically for taking feedback about teaching and evaluation and checking its adherence to the teaching plan.
- The college shall develop a comprehensive policy of felicitating and rewarding the faculty on their achievements in academics, social as well as personal life.

2. Research, Consultancy and Extension

The College aims to promote Research aptitude amongst learners and faculty by evolving micro level support system and incentive based systems. Following steps will be undertaken in this regard:

 The College shall continue conducting regular meetings of the Research Committee to identify the research potential, to promote the research and to prepare the research proposals.





- The college shall provide small scale one time research grants to faculty members within it s limits. The college shall make continuous efforts to obtain research grants from funding agencies such as UGC, ICSSR, DBT, DST, University etc.
- Academic infrastructure such as instruments, laboratories, ICT facility, Library, INFLIBNET and other requirements, as per needs for carrying out research activity shall be augmented.
- The college shall continue promoting collaborative research associations with universities, industries and institutes.

Extension activities: Following steps will be undertaken in extension activities

- Workshops shall be organized for benefitting the residents of adopted village for availing govt, schemes.
- Physical training to the alumni and candidates appearing for police and defense examinations shall be done with the help of NCC.
- The college shall provide help in maintaining the law and order during festivals to the Police department with the help of department of NCC.
- Blood Donors' directory shall be further prepared and updated for emergency use the blood shall be donated to the needy patients at free of cost.
- Training programmes shall be organized on communication skills to the teachers of primary, middle and high schools through Department of English.
- Mandatory Computer literacy programmes for disadvantaged Students, shall be organized with the help of department of Computer Science.

4. Infrastructure and Learning Resources

Following efforts will be made in this section:

- Continuous improvement of infrastructure and learning resources.
- Development of additional infrastructure and learning resources.
- Availability of adequate average area of infrastructure per student.
- Continuous efforts to obtain grants for infrastructure development.
- More specific practices of institution in respect to provision of infrastructure and Learning Resources shall be as follows:
- Construction of a College Guest House
- Construction of a separate building for Arts students
- Construction of a separate Post Graduate Block
- Extension of the Office
- Renovation of the Assam type blocks of the college hostels
- Efforts to obtain grants for infrastructure development, moderation, up-gradation from various agencies and government departments.
- Establishment of Competitive Examination training centre in the college campus
- Establishment of Sports Training Centre





5. Student Support and Progression

- All the meritorious students from academic, NSS, NCC, cultural, sports and research
 activities shall be motivated and felicitated by offering cash prizes, mementos and
 certificates.
- Additional library cards shall be provided to meritorious students.
- Sport shoes, kits and other essential articles shall be provided to the students which shall involve in sports activities.
- Arrangement of Special coaches shall be made for different games to train the students.
- Professionals from cultural field like choreographers, directors, musicians and artistes shall be invited to guide the students for promotion of cultural activities.
 - The college shall organize workshops on dance, music, theatre, fine art and literary, every year.
 - Motivate more students to take up online MOOC Courses to widen their scope of learning

6. Governance and Leadership

- Democratic and transparent organizational structure shall continue to be provided to direct access for free flow of ideas.
- Staff welfare schemes shall be strengthened.
- Effective internal control, monitoring mechanism and timely statutory audit of the accounts.

Keeping in mind the market forces, value based education, responsibilities, accountability and ownership; necessary changes will be brought into the system. Also, the college shall promote ambience of creativity and innovation by adopting quality management strategies in all academic and administrative aspects. Following Healthy practices shall be adopted by the college:

- Continuous efforts to obtain development grants from funding agencies such as UGC, ICSSR, DBT, DST, RUSA, state and central governments etc.
 - A College Health Care Fund shall be established to provide one time financial help for treatment of students, teachers and non-teaching employees of the college.





- Periodical Cleanliness programmes shall be organized in the vicinity of the college and in the neighbouring areas of Sibsagar town as part of the Swachch Bharat Mission.
- It shall be the institution's efforts to promote value-based education, social responsibilities and good citizenry through various programmes.
- Each department and every teacher in the department shall make maximum use of ICT and web based teaching-learning tools.
- Each department shall organize one national level workshop/seminar /conference every 3 years on rotation basis.
