



### **HIGHER SECONDARY ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- Date of admission for HS 1st Year is notified in the college website after announcement of the HSLC Examination results of SEBA.
- Application form along with college prospectus & syllabus is available offline from college office on the payment of Rs 250/-. It can also be downloaded from the college website <https://sibsagarcommercecollege.org.in/> .
- The applicant must register themselves in DARPAN Portal of Government of Assam with all the required documents.
- Completed Application form with all the required documents shall be uploaded in the college website on or before the last date of submission which will be notified in college website as well as in the college notice board.
- No application form shall be accepted after the last date as notified and the application form submitted incomplete will stand automatically cancelled.
- The date of interview is notified in college website and in college notice board.
- All admissions are given strictly on the merit basis and as per the reservation policy of the State Government. It gets approval of AHSEC upon satisfactory conduct of the students.
- Every student has to go through counseling sessions before taking admission.

### **Eligibility of Admission into Higher Secondary Course (10+2):**

To apply for admission into First Year class of Higher Secondary at Sibsagar Commerce College, a student has to qualify:

- (i) H.S.L.C. Examination under Board of Secondary Education, Assam (SEBA)/ CBSE.
- (ii) Any other equivalent Examination recognized by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council.



## UNDERGRADUATE (B.COM & B.A) ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Date of admission of B.com 1st Semester is notified after the announcement of the H.S. (Commerce) Final Examination Results of AHSEC and CBSE.
- Application along with the prospectus and syllabus will be available on the payment of Rs 250/- from office or it can be downloaded from the college website <https://sibsagarcommercecollege.org.in/>.
- Date of submission along with the required documents and the date of interview are to be notified in the college notice board & website. The merit list with the required cut off will be displayed in college website.
- The applicant must be present personally with all original documents at the time of interview for admission.
- All admissions are provisional and become regular by the approval of DU and upon the satisfactory conduct of the students.
- The admissions are given strictly on the merit basis and subject to the reservation for caste (ST/SC/OBC/MOBC) as per standing rule of Government.
- Students from Board/University other than AHSEC and Dibrugarh University shall have to produce Migration Certificate at the time of Admission.
- Every student has to go through counseling session before taking admission.

### Eligibility of Admission for Undergraduates:

- **Bachelor of Arts (B.A.):** A student must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council and CBSE, or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University.
- **Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.):** A student must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Commerce stream of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University. A student passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Arts or Science stream with Mathematics and/or Statistics is also eligible to apply for admission.
- **Bachelors in Computer Application (BCA):** A student must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) examinations in Arts, Science or Commerce with minimum 45% marks with Mathematics / Statistics / CASE as a subject are eligible to apply for the course.



### POST GRADUATION IN M.COM AND PGDCA

- **Masters in Commerce (M.Com):** Student must need to have a Bachelor's Degree with at least 50% marks in the relevant subject and 45% marks in aggregate in case of the candidates of General Programme or equivalent grade point.
- **Post Graduation Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA):** Student must need to have passed BA/BSC/BCOM from any recognized Indian University with minimum 40% marks.
