



## **Examination Pattern under CBCS**

CBCS means Choice Based Credit System. Choice Based Credit System is a flexible system of learning. 'Credit' defines the quantum of contents/ syllabus prescribed for a course and determines the number of hours of instruction required.

### **Semester Examination:**

- Examination and evaluation shall be done on a continuous basis, at least three times during each semester.
- There shall be 20% marks for internal assessment and 80% marks for End-semester examination in each course during every semester.
- The students shall be informed in advance about the nature of assessment. Students shall be required to compulsorily attend internal assessment including appearing the Sessional Tests, failing which they will not be allowed to appear for the End-semester examination.
- There shall be one End semester examination carrying 80% Marks in each course of a Semester covering the entire syllabus prescribed for the Course by Dibrugarh University. The end semester examination is generally a written based examination.
- The college administration makes necessary arrangements for notifying the dates of the End semester examinations and other procedures as per Dibrugarh University Rules and Regulation. Exam dates are notified in college notice board as well as in the college website.
- Student who has less than 80% attendance in average shall not be permitted to sit for the End-semester examination. Provided that it shall be open to the University to grant exemption to a student who has attended a minimum of 70% classes but failed to obtain the prescribed 80% attendance for valid reasons, on recommendation of the Principals of the College on payment of a prescribed fee.
