


Hoping that all the stake-holders of this college will come together to make the educational journey more exciting and fruitful.

Sibsagar Commerce College was established on 30th June 1969. It was brought under deficit grant- in-aid system by the government of Assam w.e.f. 01-12-1975.

The College has a distinctive position of its own in the field of higher education in upper Assam. It has been playing a significant role in creating the atmosphere among the young generation about trade commerce and Industry.

The Sibsagar Commerce College started its journey with a few students under the principalship of Gauri Bhusan Baruah and flourished in to a full fledged college under the Principalship of Smt. Dipali Chaliha.

After crossing many initial hurdles and milestones, the college crossed another milestone by the end of the year 2003 in the form of NAAC Gradation. The Principal, the teachers', office staff, students, guardians and the alumni were all geared up to face the NAAC peer team (12th & 13th Dec. 2003) & the college was finally awarded with "B" Grade. The latest feather in our cap is the re-accriditation by the NAAC peer team for the second cycle on 26th, 27th & 28th March, 2015 & have been awarded with a "B+" grade.

The college has five major departments offering B.Com Courses such as Banking, Accounting, Human Resource Management, Marketing & E-commerce. The Sibsagar Commerce College has recently introduced M.Com. regular programme under Dibrugarh University in the year 2015 and depicit an outstanding performance through academic results. The college introduced the BCA course under Dibrugarh University from the sessoion 2005-06 and it is running successfully. The BA course with major in Economics and Sociology has been running successfuly since the session 2013-14. Apart from this the college is offering Hospitality Management Courses under UGC community college scheme since 2015. It is our pleasure that some other self-financing courses such as PGDCA (Affiliated under Dibrugarh University), Carrier Oriented certificate course-E-comerce, Event Management (UGC Sponsored), and Diploma in GST have been introduced in our college in the recent past. In distance education segment college has two centers namely KKHSOU and Distance Education, Dibrugarh University. Recently college has also established an online examination centre for the benefit of students of Sivasagar District to participate competitive examinations.

Another significant contribution of SCC to the academic pursuit of Assam is that it is hoasting the Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Petrolium Technology, Sivasagar from its first academic session to till date.

The year 2019-20 was very significant for the institution as in 2019 Sibsagar Commerce College crossed a mile stone of 50 years of relentless service to the nation and make it place in the prestigious club of leading institutions of the state.

The college is managed by a Governing Body constituted by the Govt. of Assam as per provision of Assam College (Provincialisation) Act, 2005 under Assam Act No. XLVI of 2005.

















ATTENDANCE:

It is mandatory to attend classes regularly and punctually. Willful absence from the classes will be treated as a serious breach of the college discipline. As per norms, each student is required to obtain a minimum p.c. 80% of attendance to be regular candidate. If his/her p.c. of attendance is between 65% to 75% he/she will be treated as non collegiate and if he/she can not attain minimum 65% attendance, he/she will be treated as dis-collegiate. The P.C. of attendance also carries marks in the internal assessment evaluation. Therefore, the attendance needs to be taken seriously.

Regular attendance in the classes is compulsory. Students not fulfilling the AHSEC/ University norms of 75% attendance may not be allowed to take up their final examination.

Students are expected to behave in a responsible and dignified manner inside the campus of the College. Any unseemly and undesirable habits will be severely dealt with. Repeated offence could even lead to expulsion of the student from the College.

RAGGING IS COMPLETELY PROHIBITED:

- Ragging is completely prohibited. Any one found involved in this act will be expelled from the college and FIR will be lodged with the police.
- Any problem faced by the students should be brought to the notice of the principal.
- The Anti Ragging Committee of the college keeps strict vigil against any practice of ragging in the college campus.

IDENTITY CARD & COLLEGE BADGE:

Each Student is issued an Identity Card and a college badge during the time of admission. The student must carry the Identity Card while coming to the college and should wear the college badge which is a part of the uniform.

GENERAL RULES FOR MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE AND ACADEMIC ATMOSPHERE OF THE COLLEGE:

- a) The students will have to maintain high standards of discipline morality and good conduct.
- b) The students should abide by rules and regulation of the college as well as hostel as prescribed by the college authority from time to time.
- c) Violation of college rules, irregular attendance, damage of college property, discourtesy to the teachers and college staff any form, adoption of unfair means in the examination hall may lead to suspension, compulsory transfer or expulsion from the college and hostel.
- d) The students Union is to act for the greater interest of the students and the institution. It shall be subject to the guidance and control of the college authority.
- e) All powers of maintenance of discipline and healthy atmosphere of the college and hostel are vested with the Principal and his decision shall be final in these matters.
- f) Students shall leave their by-cycles, Bikes, Scooters, locked in the shed provided for the purpose. No vehicle shall be parked outside and in any other place of the college campus.
- g) Student without uniform will not be allowed to enter into the college premises.

FACILITIES:

Residential Facilities:

The college has hostel facilities for both boys and girls beautifuly furnished with almost all the essentials.

Boys Hostel (2 Nos.): Is situated at Baniabari at a distance of 3km from the main campus. The total capacity is 60 seats.

Girls Hostel (2 Nos.): Within the campus. The total Capacity is 65 seats.



Library / Reading Room/ Book Bank:

The college library has a collection of 25,000 nos. of books which include 13,250 text books and 10,402 reference books. The number of Magazines/Periodical Subscribed by the library is 9 and the no of journals subscribed is 14 (fourteen). The number of Newspapers in English and Assamese are 5 & 4 respectively. Other facilities in the library include Book-Bank, Reprographic facility Internet facility etc.

Students may borrow books from the college library against library cards. There are sufficient books for each subjects. The working hours of the library is from 09:00 am. to 4:00pm. The library has a good selection of other reference books and it has the capacity to fulfil the needs of the students and teachers alike. The library has a collection of some rare books which can be used as reference material.

There are two reading rooms attached to the library. Books are also lent from the Book Bank to the poor and meritorious students. The college library has OPAC (Online Public Access Catelouge) AND DSpace, institutional repository software facilities. Some other added features are:

- I) UGC/NRC services are also attached to the library.
- 2) Soul 2.0 Software has been introduced in the library in July 2013.

Canteen Facility:

The college has a modest canteen with all the facilities.

Internet Facility:

All the students can avail internet facility within the campus through using UGC NRC. Wi-Fi System with optical fibre cables has been introduced in the whole campus recently.

Recreational Facilities:

The college has common room facilities for both boys and girls'. There is a well developed indoor stadium. In this stadium, games such as badminton, table tennis, carrom etc. can by played at leisure time. Recently college authority developed an outdoor playground in it's Boniabari campus.





OTHER FACILITIES:

Scholarships:

Students are entitleed to get general cum merit scholarship offerd by State Govt. of Assam and UGC.

Award and Incentive:

Every year the college authority encourages meritorious students by rewarding them for their outstanding performance in academic results, sports, culture and others.

Educational Tour / Field Visit:

Educational and field study tours are conducted by the college to give an exposure to the students on different subjects.

Industrial Visit:

The College organised industrial visit for the students of Hospitality management.

Entry into Services:

The college has launched the programme of Entry into Service as per the UGC norms. In addition to the regular classes, the classes of Entry into Service have been organized for the job seeking students of the college. The college has started this programme also for the benefit of students of other local colleges.

Cheap Store:

The Development Committee of the college has started a Cheap Store since 2005 to fulfill the needs of the text books and other study materials at 5% discount rate for the students as well as to the staff of the college. The profit genererated from Cheap store is used for general development of the college. The store takes orders from students for suppllying of all kinds of books.





DIFFERENT FUNCTIONAL ORGANS OF THE COLLEGE:

WOMEN'S STUDY CELL:

With the assistance of the centre of women's studies cell of Dibrugarh University, the college established the women's studies cell in 2004 to assist women to enjoy their rights. The cell under the guidance of Mrs. Mrinali Mahanta maintains an effective linkages with different section of women of the society. Apart from this the cell is activly engaged in addressing different issues of girls students.

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION:

The Alumni Association of Sibsagar Commerce College came into being on 25th May 2002, with the aim for encouraging interaction between past and present members of the college community. At present the Association has over 150 members. The membership is open for any one who has passed out of this institution.

COMMERCE LABORATORY:

The college has developed and maintained a Commerce Laboratory to promote an activity based learing in commerce education.

CAREER COUNSELING AND PLACEMENT CELL:

The cell is formed to guide and help students academically and also undertakes personal counselling. During the course three stages of counselling are conducted; entry level, mid level and exit level. The cell organises seminars and workshops to educate and provide exposure to students with regard to the current happenings in corporate world, carrier options and employbility.

EMPLOYEES CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETY:

A Co-operative Society for the staff has been running successfully since May 1994. The teachers and office staff are its members. The members can take loans at a nominal rate of interest at the time of

Lt.(Dr) Ratul Sarmah is the ANO of the college who looks after the NCC cadets enrolled under the college in imparting NCC training, selection and sending of cadets for attending camps, appearing "B" and "C" cerificates examinations and other activities.

- b) Application form along with the Prospectus and Syllabus will be available on payment of Rs. 300/- in the college website (www.sibsagarcommercecollege.org.in).
- c) Date of submission of completed application form along with the required documents and the date of interview is notified in the college notice board & website. The merit list with the required cut off will be displayed in the college website.
- d) The applicant must be present personally with all the original documents at the time of inter view for admission.
- e) All admissions are provisional and become regular by the approval of DU and satisfactory conduct of the students.
- f)The admissions are given strictly on merit basis and subject to the reservation for caste quota (SC/ST/OBC/MOBC) as per standing rule of the Government
- g) Students from Board / University other than AHSEC and Dibrugarh University shall have to produce Migration Certificate at the time of admission.
- h) All the students will be initially given admission for general course and thereafter a departmental merit list will be prepared for honours course.



Migration fees if applicable should pay separately.

SESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS:

Sessional Examinations, unit test, GD, seminer etc. are held during the semester period and the marks secured in the sessional examination alongwith attendance are added for the internal assessment evaluation.
