



Report of Feedback from Teachers

The Teachers are vital stakeholders of the institution and therefore their feedback on curricular aspects becomes very important. The college follows the syllabus prescribed by the affiliating University in its curriculum. The Principal takes feedback on the curriculum by the end of session.

Analysis of the teachers' feedback shows that:

1. Most faculties have found that the Board of studies ensures the currency and relevance of the courses & programmes offered and are satisfied with the course content, which also has clarity about objectives.
2. Some believe that employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development, and most feel that curriculum is career-oriented, with the capacity to support students in their higher learning.
3. Almost all want more text books and the teaching resources and reference texts produced after Covid Pandemic
4. Teachers stressed the need of installation of ICT teaching aids in each classroom.
5. Teachers have the opinion to upgrade the Computer Lab to enhance students' computer literacy.
6. Teachers stressed the need to set up new buildings to accommodate students for new courses.
